

GHANA

Ghana has been our mission destination since 2009. And each year we witness God doing amazing things in the lives of people.

In 2022, our work was focused in three regions, namely Upper East, Greater Accra and Ashanti region.

We held several outreach programmes including seminars, dinner outreach, conferences and evangelism.

The lives of many people were impacted through the Gospel, mentoring and our humanitarian work.

We also supported some individuals with their tuition fees, upkeep and clothing. All in all, our work has been a blessing to some people

KENYA

Kenya is a country located in the East of Africa. Our work began in this country in 2014, through partnership with a local church. Ever since, we have been serving in Kenya in a variety of ways in sharing the Gospel and helping the needy.

In 2022, we visited Kenya and served along with Christian Life Fellowship at Buruburu, Nairobi. During this mission, together with the church, we organized conferences, seminars and also visited a home for children with special needs at Juja and made a donation of certain urgent items they needed.

We also visited another church at Arti-River, where we shared fellowship with some believers.



Kenya Orphanage Visit

Hope and Faith Home for children with special needs, located in Juja outside Nairobi. Has been a home we support annually since 2019. This home cares for children with cerebral palsy, autism and epilepsy. Our visit in 2022 enabled us to buy a few supplies this home needed to care for the wonderful children in their care.

At our European destinations, our primary aim is to teach and empower believers to make a difference through Christ wherever they find themselves. Our first visit to Belgium was in 2016, where we held a nondenominational meeting. Ever since it has been our hearts desire to continue to serve in this nation.



So part of our missions plans for 2022 included Belgium. We were delighted to be hosted by Nations Shakers centre under the leader of Ps. Frank Opoku.

Through our church partnership, we organized Believers' Summit.

Believers' Summit' is an initiative that gathers believers within a particular region to share fellowship through the word, singing and intercession. During our time in Belgium, we had the opportunity to pray for the nation and people.



GAMBIA

In September 2022, our global Lead, Edward Agyeman made a maiden journey to Gambia. Our focus for this maiden journey was to gather believers to share fellowship across denominations. By the grace of God we partnered with Christian Life Fellowship in Gambia. Through this partnership we managed to organize a nondenominational meeting which was a blessing and as a result we stood together as believers to pray for the nation.

Orphanage Visit

During our time in Gambia we also visited AF orphanage home, where we were able to encourage a group of young men and also provide them with food items and mattresses.



SIERRA LEONE

Our first mission trip to Sierra Leone was in July 2019. We were to follow up the year after, but due to the covid-19 global pandemic we were hindered.

But in 2022, we made a return visit and by God's grace carried out a few outreach activities and set up a local team whose primary focus is to take the Gospel to rural communities as well as cities.

We held our activities at Calabatown in Freetown and shared fellowship with Touching life church at Port Loko.



This is a project that utilises the Christmas festive season to reach out to children from impoverished background and communities to give a day treat of fun activities to inspire and encourage them.


In 2022, we held it in Naaga Community Kassena Nankana District, Upper East Region- Ghana.
